### Tree Inspection Program

Advisory: City Properties – Urban Forestry Tree Count & Inspection – May to August (anytime from 8am-4pm)

Please be advised that, between May and August, City staff from Urban Forestry will be conducting tree inspections on the exterior grounds to all City facilities, including CA and SRO operated properties.

#### **SCOPE OF WORK:**

The tree inspection and count will be to collect data about City-owned trees at your site; specifically data regarding (1) the species of each tree, (2) trunk circumference of each tree, (3) geo-location of each tree, and (4) the health rating of each tree.

#### **TENANT IMPACTS/INVOLVEMENT:**

To undertake the inspection, the Urban Forestry staff will be walking the exterior grounds, going from tree to tree and collecting tree data using handheld mobile devices. They will be wearing high visibility vests and their City-ID on lanyards. If your site has a washroom in public areas, or a site office for visitor sign-in, the Urban Forestry staff may also be accessing site building(s) for those limited purposes.

#### **TENANT MITIGATION:**

Should you have an outdoor event planned on your site where a tree inspection may be intrusive, please contact us and we will schedule the inspection when there is no conflict with your outdoor event.

Updates will be sent out prior to the site visit for each building.
